ULLR TOYS FOR TOTS COLLECTION

Some examples of these are Nerf guns, action figures, dolls, baby toys, games, books, puzzles and non-realistic looking weapons. TFT does accept homemade toys but asks that if you do desire to make them, that they are safe and free of sharp edges and small items that could be swallowed or otherwise injure the children that receive these donations.

Gift cards are accepted but will not be given as a gift. Gift cards, checks, and cash are used to purchase toys for distribution. Make checks payable to "Marine Toys for Tots Foundation".

Nancy Sand will deliver your donations to a TFT collection site on December 5. If you cannot attend our ULLR event, you can take a toy to any collection site, or you can mail a check/gift card to Nancy and she will deliver it later to TFT.

The mission of Toys for Tots is to collect and distribute NEW and unwrapped toys as Christmas gifts to disadvantaged children. For the last 77 years, the United States Marine Corps has distributed over 652 million toys to more than 290 million children.
